


The Ellis Journey 2018

On the 5th July 1895 the Hon Evelyn Ellis drove his new Panhard from Micheldever Station, near Winchester 56 miles to his home in Datchet, on the outskirts of Windsor. This was the first recorded journey by a motorised carriage on public roads in the UK.
